

What Is Glucoprime®

- The active ingredient of TR Pro+™ is Glucoprime® which is a β-glucan purified from yeast
- β-glucans are made of sugar and commonly found in fungi, plants and bacteria where they are a key component of the cell wall
- Not all β-glucans are the same. There is enormous diversity in the way the millions of glucose units are connected together
- The structure of the $\beta\mbox{-glucan}$ determines its ability to interact with host cells
- Extracting the β-glucan without breaking the linkages that connect the individual glucose units is technically very difficult
- Tissue Repair has successfully developed a process that seems to preserve the native structure, thereby allowing Glucoprime® to assist the healing of damaged or wounded skin



What Is TR Pro+

TR Pro+™ is a hydrogel that contains Glucoprime® which has been formulated to assist skin healing.

TR Pro+[™] can be used in most wound situations, and is particularly effective on skin that has been irritated, damaged or wounded following cosmetic and medical procedures.

Film-Forming, Flexible, Full Contact

TR Pro+TM dries to form a thin, transparent and durable protective film that stays in constant contact with the skin

Hydration And Water Loss

TR Pro+TM is absorbed into the skin to provide hydration while at the same time providing a barrier to reduce epidermal water loss^{1,2}

Aesthetic Benefit

TR Pro+™ has been shown in clinical trials to reduce skin wrinkling and increase elastosis³

Wound Healing And Scar Formation

Upon being left to dry and absorb into the skin, TR Pro+™ is not visible and can have makeup and sunscreen applied


Easy To Use And Non-Reactive



Real-World Evidence Study (2022)

Twelve dermatology clinics enrolled patients between April and September 2022 and administered TR Pro+™ following a range of procedures. The instructions specified use for at least 5 days. Patients (n=48) provided feedback via an anonymous online portal at days 6 and 28.

Most patients reported less: Dryness, Itchiness, Tingling.



Clinical Study (2022)


- Randomised, double-blind, placebo-controlled study at a single study site with 42 patients
- Standardised fractionated CO2 laser procedure on the full chest area to mimic a standardised wound and treated with active or placebo gel for 5 consecutive days with skin quality assessed at 28 and 104 days
- Validated 3- and 9-point Fitzpatrick-Goldman Wrinkle and Elastosis Scale (respectively) used to evaluate efficacy

Elastosis Proportion of patients with an improvement of at least 33%

Treatment with TR Pro+™ demonstrated a significant improvement in skin quality, as assessed by wrinkling and elastosis, after 28 days.

Directions For Use

General Instructions

On Day 1 rinse the treated areas with sterile water. Apply a generous layer of TR Pro+™ similar to the application of a mask (approximately 2-mm thick, or the thickness of a 20-cent coin) and allow the gel to absorb. The area can be covered with a loose dressing if appropriate.

On Days 2-5 rinse the affected area, apply TR Pro+™ in the evening and leave overnight. After showering in the morning apply moisturiser as necessary throughout the day if the skin surface feels dry and is intact.

After 5 days, and subject to advice from your healthcare professional, TR Pro+™ can be applied twice weekly.

When applying TR Pro+™ there may be a brief mild stinging sensation before the cooling effect of the gel becomes apparent, at which time there may also be a feeling of skin tightening which is normal. Use moisturiser through the day on intact skin if necessary.

- TR Pro+™ should not be applied to third degree (full thickness) burns or placed in contact with mucous membranes or the eyes
- TR Pro+™ should not be applied over, or used with, other skin treatments without the advice of your healthcare physician
- TR Pro+™ should not be used with any topical products containing alpha- hydroxy acids, salicylic acid, and vitamins C or E
